LOCAL RULES - REVISED OCTOBER 2023

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- Defined by fences, lines, white stakes, and beyond the stone out-of-bounds walls.

Note 1: If an out-of-bounds fence is on top of a wall, the fence posts define the edge of the course and the wall is an integral part of the course.

Note 2: When painted lines exist for a specific championship, they will only be valid for that championship and not for subsequent days if they have not been repainted.

2. INTEGRAL OBJECTS

- The pipes located near the out-of-bounds fences or walls on holes 12, 13, and 15.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- All paths with an artificial surface (asphalt, concrete, mesh), including the path that crosses holes 6 and 15, their margins, and the stones that delimit them.
- Trees that have a stake, that are less than one clubhead in height, and their tree wells.

4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- All areas marked by white or blue lines, or blue stakes.

5. PROHIBITED PLAYING AREA

- The nursery marked with stakes and blue lines located between holes 11 and 15 is a prohibited playing area in which mandatory relief must be taken without penalty under rule 16.1f.

6. BALL MAY BE PLACED

- When a player's ball lies in a portion of the general area cut to fairway height or lower, the player may take relief without penalty only once by placing the original ball or another ball, and playing it, in this area of relief:
 - ✓ Reference Point: The point of the original ball.
 - ✓ Size of the Area of Relief Measured from the Reference Point: One scorecard from the reference point, but with these limitations:
 - ✓ Limitations on the Location of the Area of Relief: » It must not be closer to the hole than the reference point, and it must be in the general area.

7. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS NEAR THE GREEN

- Local Rule Model F-5 is in effect. Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, and is: » Within two club-lengths of the green, and » Within two club-lengths of the ball.

Exception - No Relief if Line of Play is Clearly Unreasonable

There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a clearly unreasonable line of play.

8. PERMANENT OVERHEAD ELECTRIC CABLES

- Local Rule Model E-11 is in effect. If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hits overhead electric cables during the play of holes 3 or 18, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was played (see Rule 14.6 for the procedure). But only for a ball that hits an electric cable located within bounds and not for the pole that supports it.

9. SPECIFIC RULES FOR SPECIFIC HOLES

- **Hole 8:** For a ball that enters the Lateral Penalty Area. There is an optional drop zone delimited in the front right area of the bunker, only allowed when the ball crosses the margin of the penalty area by a point closer to the green than the drop zone.
- **Holes 4 and 5:** The path located to the left of both holes for buggy traffic is an immovable obstruction, however, it is considered that there is no interference and relief is not authorized if it only interferes with the player's stance.

PENALTY FOR INFRACTION OF THESE LOCAL RULES: General Penalty (2 strokes)
